

Bible Drama Scripts presents I CAN'T SEE! By Patricia Souder

SYNOPSIS: Zacchaeus asks the woman in front of him tomore over so he can see Jesus. She refuses to move and speaks derisively to her heighlor, saying she can't see why a "cheating little tax collector" like Zacchaeus would want to see Jesus . . . or why Jesus would want to see him. The ironic twist at the end challenges presuppositions about who can and who can't see.

SETTING: The crowded streets of Serie ho as Jesus comes to town.

CHARACTERS: ZACCHAEUS and WOMAN IN THE CROWD.

PERFORMANCE TIME -> minutes.

**PERFORMANCE NOTE:** Characters say lines together when marked with a star.

TOPICS: Goos grace. Salvation. Pride. Spiritual sight . . . and blindness.

PERFORMANCE POSSIBILITIES: Small groups. Street evangelism. Youth events. Sermon Ilustration.

BIBLE REFERENCE: Luke 19:1-10.
